The Graduate School of Theology and Program of Catholic Studies (GST) at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary in Philadelphia is seeking Catholics who want to pursue a fulfilling academic program of theology to help them prepare to take part in Blessed John Paul II's call for the New Evangelization. GST is a center of theological education in Philadelphia for laity, priests, and religious from the Greater Philadelphia area and the entire country. GST conducts evening, summer, and online courses in the following programs that may be relevant to students interested in Liturgical Studies:

- Church Ministry Institute
 - Academic training and formation in the Catholic Faith

- Undergraduate College Vatican Diploma
 - College level coursework in theology and ministry
