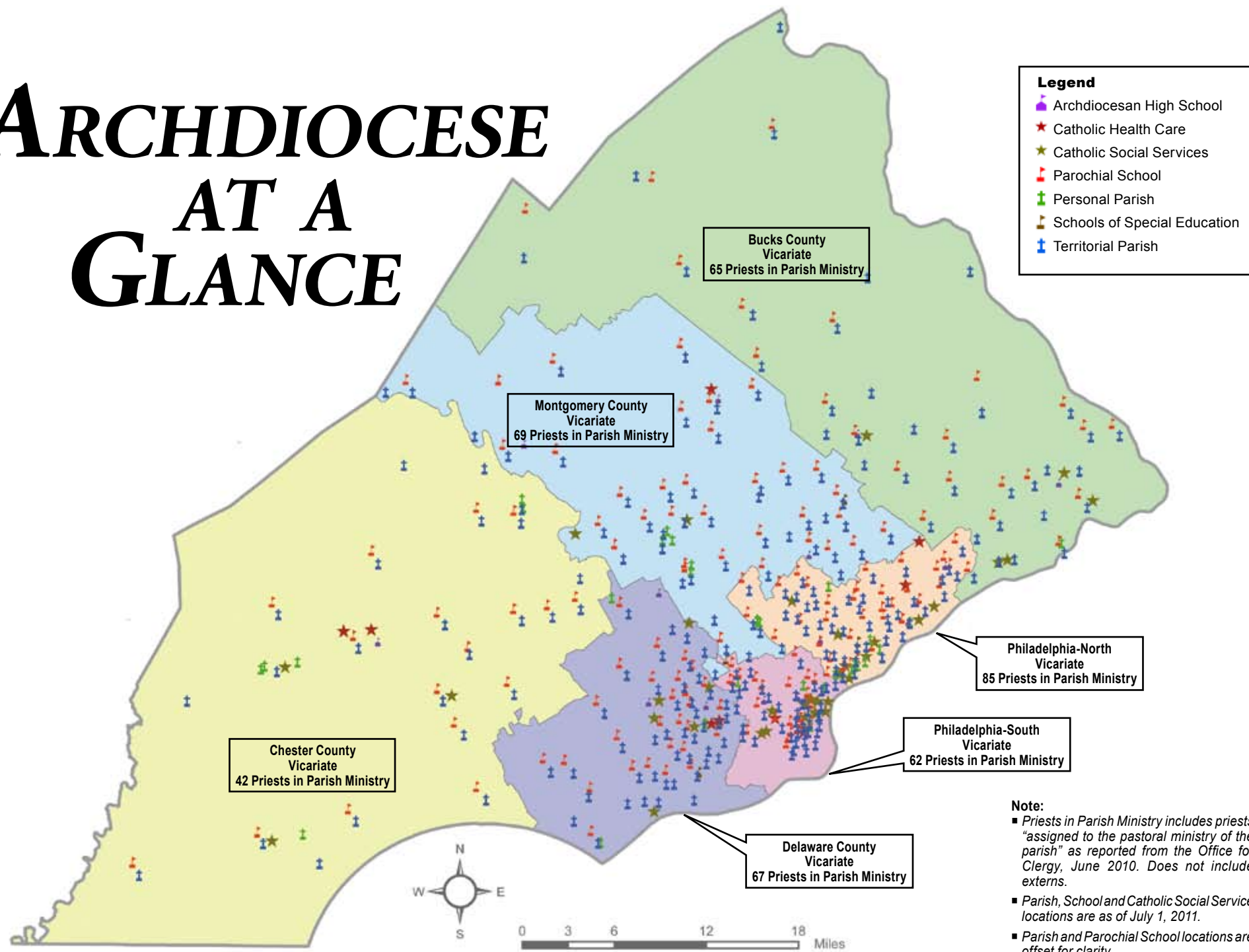


ARCHDIOCESE AT A GLANCE
