#### SAMPLE INTERCESSIONS FOR PRAYERS OF THE FAITHFUL ON MOTHER'S DAY

Below are some options from which to choose as additions to the intercessions you are already using for Masses on Mother's Day.

For women who are bearing the cross of infertility, that they may know God's loving presence and trust in His plan for them... We pray to the Lord.

For couples desiring to be parents who carry the cross of infertility, that they may trust in God's plan for fruitfulness in their marriages... We pray to the Lord.

For mothers who have lost a child through miscarriage, or at any time in their lives, that they may rest in the Lord's loving embrace and be comforted by His merciful plan for their loved ones... We pray to the Lord.

For the women who are loving spiritual mothers to us, especially our godmothers, aunts, mentors and all women who positively impact our lives... We pray to the Lord.

For couples experiencing infertility, that we as the Body of Christ may walk with them, support them and simply listen as they share their stories with us... We pray to the Lord.
